# IditaREAD Challenge

Join our new winter reading program for kids ages 3-12!

This program is modelled on the Iditarod sled dog race through Alaska. Kids will read their way through each checkpoint on the race route. For each checkpoint they hit (by reading 1 page per mile to each checkpoint) kids can move their own sled dog picture along the map, located in the front library windows. Just stop by the check out desk and let us know you've reached a checkpoint, then find your dog and move it to the correct spot!

You can move more than one checkpoint at a time, but we think it's more fun to move to each one separately so you can watch your progress! Even though the program is a "race," it's not about how fast you finish. Take your time and enjoy it. At certain major checkpoints, kids receive a small prize! Those checkpoints are marked with a "Check In" sign. Stop at the front desk to show us your log and get a prize!

Everyone who finishes the race by **5:00 pm on March 15th** gets a finisher prize and certificate! They will also be able to attend our finisher party, details TBD!
