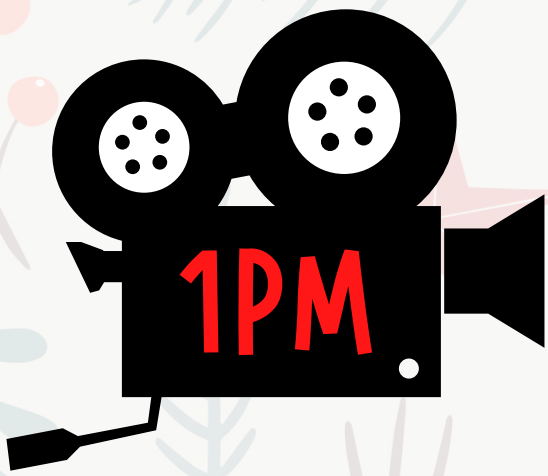

12 Days of Christmas Movies

Dec. 5: *It's a Wonderful Life* (PG, 2h 10min): An angel is sent from Heaven to help a desperately frustrated businessman by showing him what life would have been like if he had never existed.

Dec. 6: *Genie* (PG, 1h 33min): A fairy-tale comedy about a workaholic man who enlists the help of a magical genie to help win his family back before Christmas.

Dec. 9: *Candy Cane Lane* (PG, 1h 57min): A man is determined to win the neighborhood's annual Christmas decorating contest. He makes a pact with an elf to help him win--and the elf casts a spell that brings the 12 days of Christmas to life, which brings unexpected chaos to town.

Dec. 10: *Holiday in the Vineyards* (PG, 1h 47 min) Follows a widow who struggles keeping the local vineyard and raising two young boys. She may be in store for a Christmas miracle when she falls for a big city playboy who is sent to get intel on a prospective vineyard for sale.

Dec. 11: *Prancer* (G, 1h 43min) A farm girl nurses a wounded reindeer she believes is one of Santa's, hoping to bring it back to health in time for Christmas. Her holiday spirit inspires those around her, something her disheartened father is having trouble understanding.

Dec. 12: *Dashing Through the Snow* (PG, 1h 32min) A separated social worker takes his daughter on a ride-along with him on Christmas Eve.

Dec. 13: *Santa Clause 3* (G, 1h 32min): Santa, a.k.a. Scott Calvin, is faced with double-duty: how to keep his new family happy and how to stop Jack Frost from taking over Christmas.

Dec. 16: *Best. Christmas. Ever!* (PG, 1h 22min) Every Christmas, without fail, Jackie sends a boastful holiday newsletter that makes her old college friend Charlotte feel like a lump of coal. When a twist of fate lands Charlotte, her husband Rob, and their family on Jackie and her husband Valentino's snowy doorstep just days before Christmas, Charlotte seizes the opportunity to prove that her old friend's "perfect" life can't possibly be that perfect.

Dec. 17: *The Bishop's Wife* (NR, 1h 49min) A debonair angel comes to Earth to help an Episcopalian bishop and his wife in their quest to raise money for the new church.

Dec. 19: *ExMas* (PG-13, 1h 33min) Graham surprises his family at Christmas--and arrives to find his ex-fiancee already celebrating the holiday with his family.

Dec. 20: *Fred Claus* (PG, 1h 56min) Fred Claus, Santa's bitter older brother, is forced to move to the North Pole to help Santa and the elves prepare for Christmas in exchange for cash.

Dec. 23: *Holiday Affair* (NR, 1h 27min) A young widow is torn between a boring attorney and a romantic ne'er-do-well.
